
Conditions of Entry - Pets in Cabins



By entering Adelaide Airport, you accept the following conditions:

1. Only pets booked on an approved pet-friendly flight are permitted.
2. Adelaide Airport has the right to refuse entry to and remove any pet that is posing a threat to safety or causing a nuisance.
3. You bring your pet to Adelaide Airport at your own risk.
4. You are responsible for your pet at all times. If your pet causes damage to any person, animal or property, you will be held liable.
5. You must comply with all reasonable directions by Adelaide Airport staff.
6. Your pet must remain in its carrier at all times unless using an animal relief area. Your pet must be restrained with a collar/harness and lead in the animal relief area.
7. Pets are not permitted in areas where food and beverages are served (this includes lounges).
8. Pets may not be permitted in retail stores. Retailers have the right to refuse entry into their stores.
9. Pets are not permitted in the sensory room.
10. You must clean up after your pet and dispose of the waste yourself in the animal relief area bins. General waste bins must not be used.
11. You must only board and disembark aircraft by the aerobridge. You must not enter the tarmac unless directed by Adelaide Airport or airline staff.
12. Pets are not permitted on the escalators. You must use the lifts.
13. Pet carriers must not be placed on seating in the departure lounge or boarding gate and must remain on the floor.
14. Assistance animals must be given priority.
