#### Change to accessible parking at Adelaide Airport



We have some important information for people with disabilities.



We have a place for people with disabilities to get picked up and dropped off.



We call this place the **access zone**.



You can use the **access zone** for access taxis and other cars.



The access zone has moved. It used to be near the taxi rank.



The new **access zone** is outside the Atura Hotel on Atura Circuit.



It is between Atura Hotel and the airport building, also called the **Terminal**.

#### How to get to the Terminal



When you arrive at the new **access zone**, you can enter the **Terminal**.



This is the Ground floor of the **Terminal**.



To go to level 2,

Go inside the Terminal.
You will see



• 2 escalators and



• 2 lifts that can take you up.



#### On level 2, there is:

• check-in



• security,



• and departures.

#### Improvements



The old **access zone** had only 1 accessible car park.



The new **access zone** has 3 accessible car parks.



The new **access zone** has more **shade** to keep you cool and dry.

# What if I go to the old access zone?



If you go to the old **access zone** by mistake, you can still use it.



Our team will help you and tell you how to use the new **access zone** next time.

### **Leaving Adelaide Airport**



When you leave, you can use the new **access zone** or go to the **taxi rank**.



The **taxi rank** will be on your left when you leave the Terminal.



You can ask Adelaide Airport staff where the **access zone** or the **taxi rank** is.
