An exciting opportunity exists at Adelaide Airport to volunteer for the Domestic Ambassador Program. The Domestic Ambassador Program is a key part of the overall customer experience at Adelaide Airport and has been successfully operating for 20 years. The Program operates 7 days a week between the hours of 5am-9pm (0500-2100hrs) daily; with morning, afternoon and evening shifts of 4 hours duration.

As an Ambassador your key responsibilities will include:

- Welcoming travellers, visitors and business partners (Customers) to the main passenger Terminal of Adelaide Airport
- Providing information about the Airport's services & facilities to Customers; in a friendly and polite manner
- Providing assistance to Customers to ensure smooth facilitation through the Terminal

The key requirements of this role include:

- Being available to volunteer for 2 x four-hour shifts per week (includes 15 minute break) and commit to a minimum of 12 months in the program
- Ability to speak English at conversation level or above (second language is desirable)
- Excellent customer service and communication skills
- Successfully undertaking induction and training programs
- Being an Australian citizen or having an Australian Visa which permits volunteer work
- Undertaking and clearing both a police check and aviation security check
- Being physically able to perform the role, including ability to stand and move for entire length of the shift
- Being able to communicate sensitively with a range of Customers from different countries and backgrounds; including the young, the elderly and non-English speaking customers
- Wearing the Adelaide Airport Ambassador uniform with pride and in accordance with the uniform guidelines
- Having a good knowledge of Adelaide and South Australia
