The volunteer Program is a key part of the overall customer service experience at Adelaide Airport and operates 7 days a week; with four hour shifts to accommodate the international flight schedule.

## As an International Ambassador, your key responsibilities will include:

- Welcoming travellers, visitors and business partners (customers) to the main passenger Terminal of Adelaide Airport
- Aiding customers with limited English as well as supporting all other customers to ensure smooth facilitation through the International Arrivals (and sometimes Departures) processes.
- Providing information about the Airport's services & facilities to customers; in a friendly and polite manner
- Working closely with our stakeholders, including Australian Border Force, Department of Agriculture and Water Resources, Australian Federal Police and the International Airlines

## The key requirements of this role include:

- Being available to volunteer for an early morning shift once a week and commit to the 12-month Program
- Ability to speak Hindi/Vietnamese/Mandarin/Chinese and English at conversation level or above.
- Being 18 years of age or over
- Excellent customer service and communication skills
- Being an Australian citizen or having an Australian Visa which permits volunteer work
- Undertaking and clearing both a police officer check and aviation security check
- Being physically able to perform the role, including ability to stand and move for entire length of the shift
- Successfully undertaking induction and training programs
- Ability to communicate sensitively with a range of customers from different countries and backgrounds
- Wearing the Adelaide Airport Ambassador uniform with pride and in accordance with the uniform guidelines
- Having a good knowledge of Adelaide and South Australia
